The auction, which serves as one of the top generators of revenue for funding the mission and programs of the Land Conservancy, will occur in conjunction with the 7th annual "History Meets the Arts" weekend in Gettysburg, Pa., and will feature among it's many outstanding items up for bid, an original pastel painting, created especially for the Land Conservancy auction, by nationally recognized and award winning historical landscape and preservation artist Jeff Fioravanti.

"Jeff donated a signed/numbered Giclee print in 2003, and we are quite pleased to be able to offer one of Jeff's original works in this years auction" stated Land Conservancy member and auction coordinator Bob Prosperi. "Though he lives several hundred miles and states away, Jeff has worked closely with us, and has shown a great interest and appreciation for the Land Conservancy and it's efforts to protect and preserve the future of Adams County", continued Prosperi.
